

What the state charges

Your annual license fee, and the temporary license fee if you asked for one.

The annual license fee

Your annual fee is \$392.

How that number is worked out

- Your license type is 2COP.
- Pinellas County has over 100,000 residents, which the statute writes as "over 100,000".
- Beer and wine licenses carry a 40 percent surtax. The figure above already includes it, so this is the whole amount.

Across all counties this license runs \$168 to \$392. Yours is \$392 because of the county, not because of anything about your business.

The temporary license fee

Your temporary license fee is \$100.

How that number is worked out

- The rule is \$100, or one quarter of the annual fee, whichever is greater.
- One quarter of \$392 is \$98.00.
- The greater of the two is \$100, which is the \$100 floor.

Pay it with your application. The temporary license ends when the application is denied, or 14 days after it is approved, or when the permanent license is issued, whichever comes first.

What this does not cover

- Our fee. You already paid that and it is separate.
- Fingerprint costs. The Livescan vendor charges their own fee and it varies by vendor.
- Anything your city or county charges. Local fees vary a lot and we do not have a reliable list, so ask your zoning office.
- The state bills the annual fee when it approves the license, not now.

Where these numbers come from

The fee schedule is the Florida Statutes, section 56402 for this license type. The county population is the U.S. Census Bureau's 2024 estimate. The temporary license formula is section 561.181.

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
